 - Transfer students must have school records transferred.

Applicable Fees & Services Offered:

- ✓ **Enrollment Fee**
 - \$100 per single student family
 - \$150 per multiple student family
 - This fee is non-refundable and non-deductible
- ✓ **Book Fee**
 - \$150 per student [K4-12th grade]
 - Book fee for first child in family due by July 15, 2010.
 - Remaining family book fees may be prorated and incorporated into monthly tuition payments.
 - Once the school year has begun, the book fee is non-refundable.
 - Non-consumable textbooks remain the property of the school.
- ✓ **Before School Care**
 - Our building will open at 7:20 am.
 - Our students wait in the gym before school.
 - Staff does not come on duty until 7:45 so please hang onto your students as long as possible.
 - There is no charge for before school care.
- ✓ **After School Care**
 - Ordinarily we offer aftercare. And we will do so again provided we have a staff member agree to manage it.
 - Aftercare is a pay-as-you-go program available for K4-8th graders.
 - Aftercare begins @ 3:45 pm and runs to 5:15 pm.
 - The charge for aftercare per student is \$3.00 for the first hour and 15 minutes. [up to 5:00 pm] After 5:00 pm, there is an additional charge of \$2.00 per student for a total due of \$5.00 per student up to 5:30 pm.
 - After 5:30 pm, each additional 5 minutes is \$5.00.
 - There is no reduction for additional children.
- ✓ **Preschool & Kindergarten Classroom Party Fee**
 - \$7.00 per student
- ✓ **Graduation Fees—**
 - K5--\$5.00
 - 8th Grade--\$10.00
 - 12th Grade--\$30.00 **[This fee covers diplomas, transcripts, this does not include high school announcements, caps, gowns, etc.]**
- ✓ **Snack [K4-K5]**
 - Snack is included in the price of the tuition.
 - A small morning and afternoon snack will be served.
 - Be sure to let teacher know if your student has any food allergies.
- ✓ **Breakfast**
 - A limited breakfast menu is available.
 - Breakfast hours are 7:50 am-8:15 am.
- ✓ **Lunch Account [All grades]**
 - Lunch accounts can be maintained in the office.
 - Our Senior Class operates our "Deli" and we have a limited selection of items available.
 - The lunch menu is provided at Family Orientation in August.
 - Warm-ups remain \$0.25 each.

Enrollment Policy Agreement

To Members of Muncie Christian School:

I have read and signed your Articles of Faith and your objectives as set forth. I am willing to have my child(ren) trained in accordance with them. I also understand that:

1. **It will be necessary for me to:**
 - a. Maintain regular tuition payments,
 - b. Be of practical help;
 - c. Pray for the needs of the school;
 - d. Cooperate in fulfilling the school policies as set forth in the student handbook.
2. **I understand that there is a dress code** and I agree that my children will abide by the policy set forth in the Student/Family Handbook.
3. I understand and agree that, during my child's enrollment, the courses offered and the instructors teaching them may change from time to time according to the discretion of the school leadership.
4. The teacher has full authority in the classroom discipline of my child(ren).
5. My child(ren) will go on scheduled field trips and other school activities.
6. The school board reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not respect its spiritual standards and cooperate in fulfilling the educational goals of the school.

The Muncie Christian School financial policy for 2010/2011 School year is as follows:

1. **A NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-DEDUCTIBLE enrollment fee is required** to reserve a place for each student.
 - a. \$100 for a single student;
 - b. \$150 for two or more students
2. The enrollment fee and completed packet are required before child's spot is held.
3. Absolutely no spots will be "held" for any student.
4. There is a \$150 Book Fee per student that must be paid in full by July 15, 2011. [This fee is due for the first child in family, other family book fees may be prorated and incorporated into monthly tuition payments.] No student will be allowed to begin school without this fee paid in full.
5. A 10-month tuition plan is available.
6. All tuition accounts must be paid in full by May 1, 2011.
7. Unused tuition will be refunded. Please note that tuition is prorated to the number of months, not days, the student has attended school. There is no prepayment penalty.
8. Students with tuition accounts in arrears will not be allowed to participate in end of year activities, this includes all graduation activities.
9. NO transcripts, grade cards, or diplomas will be released until accounts are paid in full.
10. Students with accounts in arrears can be removed from the classroom until account is brought current.
11. Any account 45 days delinquent will be subject to School Board action, which includes not allowing the student to not attend school until the account is current.
12. A late fee of \$10.00 per month will be assessed after account goes 10 days past due.
13. There will be a \$30 fee applied to all payments returned NSF. [This includes Debit/Credit Card Refusals].
